Inspect the Work Site Daily

The winter may bring sudden dangerous weather changes. <u>It's important for supervisors to inspect the work site before releasing construction workers to start working.</u>

Any new hazards should be dealt with before work begins.

Remove Ice and Snow before Starting Work

Construction workers have enough obstacles causing danger at the work site. They don't need to add ice and snow into the mix. Make sure all ice and snow has been removed and salt has been put down on any large patches of ice <u>before starting work</u>.
