	Determine what type of ladder is appropriate for your current work environment	
	Confirm that the ladder is the appropriate length for the task	
	Check that your ladder has the proper Duty Rating	
	Thoroughly inspect the ladder to ensure it is in good working condition	
	Clean the climbing and gripping surfaces	
	Read the safety information label(s) on the ladder	
	Reminders about your surroundings	
	Confirm that the ground where the ladder is set-up is firm and level	
	Confirm that any surrounding doors are blocked open, locked or proper guarded	ly
H-H	Ensure that the weather is sufficiently safe for using a ladder	
	Reminders for YOU	
	Clean the soles of your shoes to maximize traction and avoid slipping	
	Ensure that you are not tired, dizzy or prone to losing your balance befo using the ladder	re
	Use towlines, a tool belt or an assistant to convey materials so that your hands are free when climbing	-
$\vee$ $V$	Maintain three points of contact with the ladder while climbing
